

For internal FX processing and live looping, the band brings an Radial mic-splitter on stage, next to the piano.

Phantom should be provided by FOH.

The red labeled channels are plugged in this splitter.

Preferably, an XLR snake for picking up the signal after the splitter for FOH is placed near the piano.

In case this is not possible, the band will bring a separate set of mics.
